Conservation Committee Goals and objectives April 2020

- 1. Support conservation of rare plants via the Rare Plant Symposium and promotion of Important Plant Areas.
- 2. Advise on and support legislation conserving Colorado native plants and plant communities.
- 3. Advise land managers by commenting on proposed actions and by and providing letters of support for sustainable management practices of native plants and native plant communities.
- 4. Increase the visibility of CoNPS as an advocate for native plants.
- 4a. Assist local Chapters in identifying and advocating for local conservation issues.
- 4b. Generate and maintain partnerships with other entities in order to promote the conservation of Colorado native plants and plant communities.
- 4c. Encourage members to engage in conservation efforts with CoNPS and other entities.
- 4d) Upon authorization from the Operating Committee, intervene in rulemaking or other legal proceedings to advance legal protections for Colorado plants and plant communities.
- 5. Educate CoNPS members and the public about conservation issues by the publication of the "Conservation Corner" column in Aquilegia and Committee updates in enewsletters.
